COVID-19 INFORMATION: COMPETITORS: No entries will be accepted from any competitor where their region of residence is locked down. SCRUTINEERING: Will be held from 3pm to 5pm on Friday the 8th April at the Honda Shop, 3 Rolfe Way, Putāruru 3411. Face masks to be worn when inside the scrutineering venue. We encourage competitors that live closer to the event to arrive in the first hour of scrutineering to allow those that are travelling further to be scrutineered between 4 and 5pm.
