

South Waikato Club Red Traffic Light Trial RULES

Government requirements RE: Public events

At Red: There will be no limits for outdoor activities — like gatherings and events, and there will be a 200-person limit for indoor gatherings and events. There is no requirement to use vaccine pass or provide or use QR scanning. It is the responsibility of **everybody**, competitor, official, crew member, volunteers, or club member to ensure that we do our bit to ensure we manage the events to reduce the likelihood of transmission happening.” From “Back in Motion” document, Motorsport NZ.

EVENT ENTRY

- All entries are done online
- No entries will be accepted from any competitor where their region of residence is locked down
- All competitors and crew must acknowledge they are fit and healthy prior to the attendance.
- Attendees must adhere to all government COVID-19 regulations and guidelines - If you have cold, flu or COVID-19 symptoms, stay home, please do not attend this event. Hand sanitiser should be used

CONTACT TRACING

- Not required.

SCRUTINEERING

- Face masks to be worn when inside the scrutineering venue.

CREW

COMPETITOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL CREW ALLOCATED TO YOUR TRUCK.

ANY CREW NOT adhering to these rules and COVID-19 rules & guidelines will be asked to leave the site instantly and run the risk of their truck also been removed from the event

PRIZE GIVING

- The prize giving will be held at an indoor venue in Putaruru with a 200 person limit in line with the government requirements. Venue staff and volunteers (ENCC and host club members) running prize giving are not part of the 200, as per the government guidelines and must wear a face covering.
- Face masks to be worn at prize giving, unless eating or drinking.

COMPETITORS

Any competitor not adhering to COVID rules and guidelines will be removed from the event, no questions asked.
